

Election for ITU's Internal Working Environment Organisation

It is time for the election of our Internal Working Environment Organisation.

Five Working environment representatives must to be elected among members of staff who do not have management tasks.

The elected period is for two years starting from 1 February 2019.

Do you want to run for the Work environment representative election?

If you want to be a candidate, you must be permanently employed and must have been employed at ITU for at least nine months.

You will be a candidate for the safety group in which you are employed (see the safety groups below), and you must participate in an obligatory safety course of three days within the first three months of the elected period. Furthermore, you will be offered additional courses.

If you want to run for the election, please send an e-mail to me (nine@itu.dk) in which you notify that you run for the Working environment representative election. **The deadline is 26 November 2018.**

When the deadline has passed, the election will be called if there is more than one candidate for any of the safety groups.

The five safety groups

- **Safety Group 1** (Facilities Management + IT Department + Communications)
- **Safety Group 2** (Finance and Personnel + Student Affairs and Programmes + Research Support + Learning Support)
- **Safety Group 3** (Business IT)
- **Safety Group 4** (Computer Science)
- **Safety Group 5** (Digital Design)

Current Working environment representatives:

- **Jesper David** (Safety Group 1) – *up for re-election*
- **Pia Sødequist** (Safety Group 2) – *up for re-election*
- **Christina Neumayer** (Safety Group 5) – NOT *up for re-election*

Safety Group 3 and 4 do not have a Working environment representative at this point.
